Minutes of the 114th Annual General Body Meeting held at 09.00 AM on Saturday, the 2nd October 2021 at Thiruvalluvar Arangam, IV Floor, Centenary Building, IOA Complex

The 114th Annual General Body Meeting of Indian Officers' Association was attended by 791 Life Members (as per Attendance Register). The proceedings of the AGBM commenced with the invocation of "Tamil Thai Vazhthu".

2. The day being the Gandhi Jayanthi Day, the statue and portrait of the 'Father of the Nation' decorated the dais prominently and the President i/c and all the Executive Committee Members of the Indian Officers' Association paid floral respects to Mahathma Gandhiji and started the proceedings.

3. Thiru R. Murthy, Vice President II of the Association proposed Thiru Frank Stephen Louis, President i/c to preside over the 114th Annual General Body Meeting and this was seconded by Thiru P. Baskaran, Executive Committee Member.

Thereafter, two minutes silence was observed in respect and remembrance of the Life Members who passed away after the previous General Body Meeting.

Thiru R. Murthy, Vice President II extended hearty welcome to all the office bearers and the Life Members to the Annual General Body Meeting and then requested Thiru Frank Stephen Louis, President i/c to conduct the proceedings of the AGBM.

4. Thiru Frank Stephen Louis, President i/c commenced his address with the invitation to the office bearers and Life Members and extended thanks for their participation. He mentioned that in the last four years, he had functioned as Joint Secretary, General Secretary, Vice President and President and thanked everybody for their cooperation and well wishes throughout his tenure. He said that during the last year, in spite of several difficulties, the administration has implemented several welfare measures for the benefit of the Life Members and listed out some of the benefits extended.

- Medical benefits have been provided by restoring the clinic for the benefit of the Life Members of the Indian Officers' Association. The certification for Registration of the Clinic Has been obtained from the Directorate of Medical and Rural Health Services and now the clinic can purchase medicine from the Pradhan Manthri Bharatiya Janaushadi Pariyojana ensuring medicines at cheaper rates for the use of the Life Members. Because of this, IOA has saved an amount of Rs. 1.50 lakh on every purchase made bimonthly.
- The second floor of Centenary Building was rented out to Tamil Nadu Manual Workers Social Security and Welfare Board and a rent of around Rs. 89 lakhs received by IOA.
- IOA had filed an appeal in the High Court against the notice of Income Tax Department and actively pursued the case. Due to the efforts of this association, IOA has saved an amount of Rs. 59 lakhs.
- For the convenience of the Life Members, convenient lounge with air conditioned facilities has been provided.

With the above, the President i/c concluded his opening speech stating that he has to shorten his speech due to shortage of time and in view of the impending election. The Life Members applauded.

5. The President i/c then invited the General Secretary i/c to present the Annual Report. In response to this, Thiru R. S. Shrinivasan, General Secretary i/c commenced his address by extending warm welcome to all the Life Members of the Association. He said that the members have been presented with the Annual Report and Accounts, which they would have gone through and the time paucity prevents the whole presentation again before the Life Members. To a request to express their approval, the members present unanimously consented their approval. Then he expressed sincere gratitude to all the Life Members for having provided an opportunity to serve the interest of the Life Members. He pointed out that the entire world was affected by the break out of corona and this had affected the functioning to a larger extent. He added that due to this, the outgoing Executive committee may have failed at times to fulfil the expectation of the members for which he requested the Life Members to excuse. The General Secretary i/c informed the Life Members that with the honesty and hard work of the outgoing Executive Committee, the Indian Officers' Association has deposited around Rs. 1 crore in the bank deposit, which was received with cheer by the Life Members. Then Thiru R.S. Shrinivasan, General Secretary i/c mentioned that the Annual General Body Meeting, which used to be conducted for one whole day had to be cut short because of the corona times and the impending elections of the new office bearers and Executive Committee members. He then requested the Life Members to extend

same amount of cooperation and encouragement to the Executive Committee expected to take charge after the elections.

6. After this, Thiru Frank Stephen Louis, President i/c requested Thiru R. Dorai, Treasurer i/c to present the Annual Accounts. Thiru R. Durai, Treasurer i/c, after extending welcome to Life Members, presented the Annual Accounts for the year ending March 2021. At this point, Thiru Muthuveeraganopathy, Life Member raised certain clarifications, which were cleared first by Thiru R. Durai, Treasurer i/c and then in more detail by the Statutory Auditor. Then the Annual Accounts was passed unanimously by the General Body.
7. Thereafter, Thiru Frank Stephen Louis, President i/c sought the approval of the following from the Life members present for the Annual General Body Meeting
 - i. Confirmation of the Minutes of the Special General Body Meeting held on 21.02.2021
 - ii. Approval of Annual Report and Statements of Accounts for the year 2020-2021 with Auditors Report
 - iii. Appointment of M/s. G.V.N. Shankar & Co as the Statutory Auditor for the year 2021 – 2022 for Indian Officers' Association
 - iv. Election of office bearers and Executive Committee Members for the year 2021 – 2023

The Life Members present for the Annual General Body Meeting unanimously approved the above matters.



10. The Annual General Body Meeting was followed by the Election of Office Bearers and Executive Committee Members for the year 2021 – 2023. The election was conducted between 10.00 AM and 05.00 PM on 02.10.2021. The election was conducted under the flawless supervision of Dr. Jothikumar, Election Officer and the Election Team.
