The AGM Agenda Subjects were discussed.

1. To confirm the Minutes of 114th AGM held on 02.10.2021.

The Minutes of the 114th AGM held on 02.10.2021 was approved in the 115th AGM on 18.09.2022 without any modification.

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2. To approve Auditors' Report for the year ended March, 2022

The Auditors' report for the year 2021-2022 was approved by the General Body. The EC requested the General Secretary to give instruction to the Auditors to file the Audited report in the Income-Tax Department.

3. To approve appointment of Statutory Auditors M/s. Sundram & Srinivasan, Chartered Accountants as IOA Statutory Auditors for next three years 2022-23, 2023-2024 and 2024-2025.

The AGM approved the appointment of M/s. Sundaram & Srinivasan, Chartered Accounts as IOA Statutory Auditors for the next three years. The EC requested the General Secretary to issue appointment order to M/s.Sundaram & Srinivasan as IOA Statutory Auditors for the next three years 2022-23, 2023-2024 and 2024-2025.

4. Introduction of Postal Ballot Paper System in IOA.

Part-3 Management Section 15(i)

A member of the EC shall be elected in the AGM Meeting from among the life members and he/she shall hold office for three years from the date of election. The EC resolved to give effect to the amended bye-law after getting approval from the Registrar of Societies.
